Carefully selected for its prime location in the Northern Serengeti, close to the Mara River, this intimate tented camp places you in the northern part of the Serengeti close to the Mara River, perfect for experiencing the annual Great Migration. From here, you have an excellent opportunity to encounter the migrating herds as they move through the Northern Serengeti and, with the right timing and a little luck, you may even witness one of nature's most dramatic spectacles – wildebeest and zebra attempting to cross the Mara River. Of course, river crossings are entirely dictated by the animals and the conditions on the day, so there can never be a guarantee that a crossing will take place during your stay. This unpredictability is part of what makes the experience so extraordinary. Your camp's location gives you the best possible chance of being in the right place when the herds are on the move. The camp itself offers an authentic and intimate safari experience without compromising on comfort. Spacious en-suite canvas tents blend seamlessly into the surrounding wilderness, with comfortable beds, hot showers, delicious cuisine, and warm Tanzanian hospitality. Its unfenced setting allows wildlife to move freely through the area, creating an immersive connection with the surrounding wilderness. Today is designed to give you time to unwind after your journey. Relax on your private veranda, take in the spectacular surroundings, and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of camp as you recover from any jet lag. 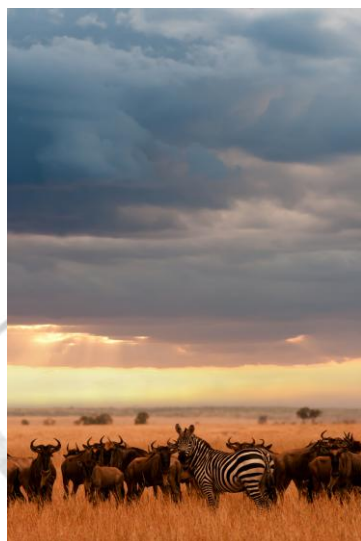

- Depending on the duration and nature of your stay, vaccinations for Hepatitis B, Typhoid, and Yellow Fever may be advised.
- A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate may be needed if you are travelling from or transiting through a country where the disease is endemic.
- Preventative treatment and protective measures against Malaria are recommended.

Health recommendations may vary slightly between EU countries, so travellers should consult their doctor or a travel health clinic well in advance of departure.
